



Webinar or Webcast Verification of Participation

When an online event is delivered with BeaconLive, each participant is automatically tracked upon their connection and disconnection from the web room using the personalized pin numbers provided to the individual upon registration. Additional verification tools are available using BeaconLive's Continuing Education Platform (BeaconCE) to provide more in-depth monitoring and tracking of participation throughout the lifecycle of an online event. Several of the BeaconCE Platform methods, or a combination of a few, meet many of the Accredited Bureau's requirements for verification of attendance and participation during an online continuing education event.

Additional Verification and Monitoring Tools through BeaconCE:

- A Verification of Participation notification box appears embedded in the web room randomly throughout the webinar or webcast. These "pop-up" boxes require the participant to type in a customized code as displayed in the box. Verification boxes can appear in many intervals during the event to suit the host's or accredited bureau's needs.
- Live Polls and Surveys can be conducted throughout the online event by the presenter. Responses (or clicks) made during the Survey or Polls are recorded and available in a Post-Conference Report to the host.
- BeaconLiveWeb provides participants with the ability to ask questions of the presenter, hosts or BeaconLive Moderators to address any technical issues or to participate during the Q&A Session using the "Chat" feature in the BLW browser. All communication made via the "Chat" box is recorded and available in the Post-Conference Report.
- The ability to host an Evaluation/Survey following the delivery of the live event or viewing the OnDemand streaming event are available upon the host's request.
- Administration of a Final Exam following the event requiring a minimum score to attain pass/fail/retake is available upon the host's request.
- OnDemand recordings in MediaHub can include a link to any combination of material evaluation, quiz and/or certificate embedded at the end of the recording. The participant must watch all but the final 10 minutes of the recording in order for the link to show (they cannot just scroll to the end to reach the link).
- Final Certification following the successful participation or completion of a Final Exam are available through BeaconLive, available upon host's request.
